### GRANT INFORMATION

The College Cost Reduction and Access Act of 2007 created the Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program, which provides up to \$4,000 per year (\$8,000 total for graduate programs) in grants to graduate students who commit to 1) teach full-time 2) in high-need subject areas 3) for at least four years AND 4) at schools that serve students from low-income families. If the commitment is not fulfilled, the grant is permanently converted to an Unsubsidized Federal Direct Loan with interest calculated back to the date the funds were disbursed. *\*Due to sequestration the annual maximum Teach Grant is \$3,728.*

If I fail to meet all the conditions of the award or if the conditions are not documented as required, I understand that the award will be permanently converted to an Unsubsidized Direct Federal Stafford Loan and that I will be responsible to repay this loan with interest calculated from the disbursement date of the grant. I understand that once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan it cannot be converted back to a grant.
