I recently learned of openings at The Day School through your ad in *The New York Times*. I am currently seeking a position as a Head Teacher in a 4-5's or 5-6's classroom. As a recent graduate of Bank Street College of Education, I have had the opportunity to experience rich and varied classroom environments. My experiences with young children led to my interest in teaching children ages 4-6.

As a student teacher at P.S. 75, I had the chance to develop an exciting integrated social studies unit related to St. John the Divine Cathedral in Manhattan, as well as assist in a mapping unit involving mapping through the use of manipulatives (a large scale floor plan of the school was created). At the Bank Street School for Children, I had the opportunity to student teach in a 4-5's classroom. I helped develop a science unit based on the study of plant life, worked with small groups on story writing and experienced a hands on environment for children.

These experiences have shown me how children build on knowledge through their experiences in the environment. All parts of the curriculum tie together to create a whole. I would like the opportunity to bring my experiences into my own classroom, as children expand their world socially and intellectually.
