## **Transcript Notations**

The <u>Clery Act</u> was a measure taken to require all colleges and universities to report crimes of violence, including but not limited to sexual violence. This law requires that institutions must make a notation in a student's transcript if they have been:

- "Suspended after a finding of responsibility for a code of conduct violation" or
- "Expelled after a finding of responsibility for a code of conduct violation" or
- "Withdrew with conduct charges pending"

There are few policies that guide the reporting and removal of transcript notations. They are:

- Notations cannot be removed prior to one year after the conclusion of the suspension
- Notations for expulsion can never be removed
- If a finding of responsibility is vacated for any reason, the transcript notation will be removed
